FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS SHEET Revised: January 2023

- Q: What are my voting rights in the condominium association?
 - A: Each unit has one (1) vote. Voting for the Board of Directors is to be done by secret ballot at the Annual Meeting.
- Q: What restrictions exist on my right to use my unit?
 - A: The Rules and Regulations should be followed by each unit owner. See Rules and Regulations.
- Q: What restrictions exist on the leasing of my unit?
 - A: There is a minimum rental requirement of ninety days (90). Tenants must fill out a lease approval form and be approved by the Board of Directors. No business for profit may be run from a unit. Tenants may not sub-lease their units.
- Q: How much are my assessments to the condominium association for my unit type and when are they due?
 - A: Assessments are due monthly. Assessments are late ten (10) days after the due dates.
- Q: Do I have to be a member in any other association?
 - A: NO
- Q: Am I required to pay rent or land use fees for recreational or other commonly used facilities?

- Q: Is the condominium association involved in any court cases in which it may face liability in excess of \$100,000?
