Pointe West Master Property Owners Association ARC Hurricane Shutter Guidelines Modified: February 14, 2023

All homes in Pointe West must follow the guidelines listed below with the follow exception: North Village Townhome Sub-Association only allows roll-down shutters for all elevations.

Front Elevation:

Colonials - must match the original shutter color or the color of the trim of the home Roll-down - manual or electric

Panels - steel, aluminum, or clear

Bahamas - second floor only - must match trim color

Accordions

Side Elevation:

Colonials - must match the original shutter color or the color of the trim of the home

Roll-down - manual or electric

Panels - steel, aluminum, or clear

Bahamas - must have a barrier of shrubs/material as deep as shutter extends - must match trim color

Accordions

Lanais - may be enclosed with accordion shutters or hurricane rated screens

Rear Elevation:

Colonials - must match the original shutter color or the color of the trim of the home Roll-down - manual or electric

Panels - steel, aluminum, or clear

Bahamas - must have a barrier of shrubs/material as deep as shutter extends - must match trim color

Accordions

Lanais - may be enclosed with accordion shutters or hurricane rated screens

Front Door:

Roll-down - manual or electric Panels - steel, aluminum, or clear Accordions

Color:

Accordions - must be white, ivory, or beige Roll-ups - must be white, ivory, or beige Hurricane rated screens - color must be approved by the ARC

Additional Requirements:

Colonial shutters must be installed on the left and right sides of the windows.

Arched front windows must have arched colonial shutters or panels.

All installations must be approved by the ARC.

Homeowners are required to have contractor obtain a permit from Indian River County.
