Regarding Meeting Notices

720.303(2)(c)

1. "...The association may provide notice by electronic transmission in a manner authorized by law for meetings of the board of directors, committee meetings requiring notice under this section, and annual and special meetings of the members to any member who has provided a facsimile number or e-mail address to the association to be used for such purposes; however, a member must consent in writing to receiving notice by electronic transmission."

Regarding Responsibility of Receiving Electronic Communication

720.303(4)(g)

"...The association shall also maintain the electronic mailing addresses and the numbers designated by members for receiving notice sent by electronic transmission of those members consenting to receive notice by electronic transmission. The electronic mailing addresses and numbers provided by unit owners to receive notice by electronic transmission shall be removed from association records when consent to receive notice by electronic transmission is revoked. However, the association is not liable for an erroneous disclosure of the electronic mail address or the number for receiving electronic transmission of notices."

Regarding Amendment Changes

720.306(1)(b)

"...The copies and notice described in this paragraph may be provided electronically to those owners who previously consented to receive notice electronically."
